The Will of William Tregegan of the Parish of St. Veryan in the County of Cornwall, written 16 Apr 1630, proved 6 Sep 1630.*

* Spelled 'Tregigean' on the wrapper.

The xvith day of aprell anno dom: 1630.

In the name of god amen I William Tregegan of the p'ish [of] Verian in the Countie of Cornawall being sicke in boddie butt of memory I thanke my god doe make this my last w[ill] and testament in manner and forme following

First I bequeth my soule to god my savior and my [body to] Christian buriall.

Itm. I give and bequeth unto the poore [of the] p'ish of Cury iij^s iiij^d.

Itm. I give and bequeth unto the p[oore of the] p'ish of Gonwulloe iij^s iiij^d.

Itm. I give and bequeth [unto] the poore of the p'ish of Verian x^s.

Itm. I give and [bequeth] unto **Leonard Tregegan my eldest sonne** vii^l whereof the in his hands already.

Itm. I give and bequeth unto **T[homas] Tregegan my second sonne** vii^l

Itm. I give and beque[th unto] **my thurde sonne Paskowe Tregegan** vii^l to be payd [to] him when hee shall acomplish the age of xxi yeres.

[Itm] I give and bequeth unto **John Tregegan my youngest sonn[e]** vii^l to be payd unto him when hee shall acomplish the ag[e of] xxith yeres.

Itm. I give and bequeth unto **Lowdie Trege[gan] my eldest dafter** xx^l to be payd unto her when sh[e shall] acomplish the age of xxi yeres.

Itm. I give and b[equeth] unto **Elyzebeth Tregegan my youngest dafter** xx^l to [be] paid unto her when she shall acomplish the age of x[xi] yeres.

Itm. I give unto my **Thomas Tregegans** three chi[ldren] x^s to be equally devided betwene them.

Itm. I give [and] bequeth unto Katheren my sarvand mayd j^s. iiij^d.

Itm. I give and bequeth unto Nicholas my sarvant boye j^s. iiij^d.

Itm. I give and bequeth unto **Elyzebeth Tregegan my wife** all my tene[ment] in Cherverlou within the p'ish of Gon Wallow for terme of hir life my estate doe so longe Contenue and after hir decease the tenement shalbe to remaine to one of my fower sonnes my said wife shall thinke best of During my indure and that sonne shalbe to pay out of the said Ten[ement] unto my other three sonnes the full and some of of Corent mony to be equally devided betwene them Always my will is that if ethe of my children doe Chan. before the tim mencioned that the the legesie give.

All the Residue of my goods and Ch[attels] not given nor bequethed I give and bequeth unto **Elyzebeth Tregegan my wife** and shee I make my solle Executor [to] pay my Debts and legesies and to see this my last will [and] testament performed In Witness whereof I unto my signe the Day and yere above written.
