Abstract of the Will of Elizabeth Trevenen now of the Parish of Helston in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 11 Jan 1796, proved 24 Apr 1798.

Desires that she be buried in the parish of Camborne near **her deceased husband** the Rev^d. **John Trevenen**.

Gives £500 to **her son John Trevenen**.

Gives £500 to the Rev^d **Tho^s Trevenen**.

Gives £500 each to **her daughters Elizabeth Penrose the wife of Charles Penrose**, and **Jane Penrose wife of the Revd. John Penrose**.

Gives £500 to **her grand-daughter Elisabeth Farquharson Trevenen, daughter of her son James Trevenen**, deceased, to be paid to her when she turns twenty-one, appointing **her two sons John Trevenen, Esq.** and the Rev^d **Thos: Trevenen** trustees of Elisabeth's inheritance during her minority.

Gives to 8 guineas to niece? Constance Nichols now living at Truro.

Gives 6 guineas to the poor widows of Camborne.

Gives 4 guineas to the poor widows of Helston.

Gives 5 guineas each to her two maids.

Gives to her daughters, Elizth. Penrose and Jane Penrose, her household furniture, linen and clothing, appointing them co-executrices of her last will and testament.
