

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/1711/196.

Abstract of the Will of William Trevenen of the Borough of Helston in the County of Cornwall, Gentleman, written 5 Nov 1825, proved 13 Apr 1826.

Gives to whichever of his sons first turns twenty-one, his gold watch, chain and seals.

Gives £30 to his wife as well as all his household goods, furniture, plate, linen, china and other effects.

All the rest of his goods, chattels, personal and testamentary estate, he gives to his relatives and friends, the Rev. **John Trevenen** and **Humphrey Millett Grylls**, gentleman, in trust, for the benefit of his widow and children. Appoints his trustees, the said John Trevenen and Humphrey Millett Grylls, co-executors of his will.
