Abstract of the Will of Richard Trevithick of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Miner, written 8 Jul 1797, proved 1 Aug 1797.

Gives to **his wife Ann** his tenement and premises in Penponds in the parish of Camborne, along with sums of money totaling £350.

Gives to **his daughter Elizabeth the widow of John Tyack the younger** his tenement and premises at Hayle, along with sums of money totaling £486.

Gives to **his daughter Ann the wife of William Edwards** his tenement and premises at Churchtown in Camborne, as well as half of his two tenements at Pencothen in Camborne and Gwithian, and sums of money totaling £200.

Gives to **his daughter Thomasine the wife of Henry Vivian** the other half of the two tenements at Pencothen, along with sums of money totaling £150.

Gives £5 4s. to **his sister? the wife of Andrew Johns**.

Gives £3 3s. to **his niece Elizabeth Saunders**.

All the rest of his property, goods and chattels, he gives to **his son Richard Trevithick**, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
