Gives to William Edmonds the house in Pellow Townplace.

Gives £5 to his daughter Esther Pascoe.

Gives £5 each to his grandchildren, the children of his sons John and Benjamin.

All the rest of his goods, chattels, credits and effects he gives to **his daughter Ann Harvey** and William Edmunds, appointing them co-executors of his last will and testament.
