Abstract of the Will of Matthew Trewhella of the Parish of Towednack in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 16 Nov 1814, proved 3 May 1815.

Gives £1 1s. to his son Matthew, to be paid to him when he turns twenty-one.

Gives £1 1s. to **his son John**, to be paid to him when he turns twenty-one.

Gives £25 to his son Chrestover, for when much needed from time to time.

Gives £1 1s. to his son Marten, to be paid to him when he turns twenty-one.

Gives £25 to his daughter Alicey, for when much needed from time to time.

Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Hannah**, to be paid to her when she turns twenty-one.

Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Ann**, to be paid to her when she turns twenty-one.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives to **his wife Alicey Trewhella**, whom he appoints sole executrix of his last will and testament, as long as she remains a widow. If his wife remarries then she receives 5 shillings, and the rest remains in the care of **his brother William** and **her brother Matthew**.
