

*Abstract of the Will of Hart Udy of the Parish of Luxulyan in the County of Cornwall, written 6 Jun 1762, proved 6 Aug 1762.*

Gives £1 1s. to **his wife Catherine**, four pewter dishes, six pewter plates and other items.

Gives 5 shillings to Jane Lukey.

Gives 5 shillings to Thomas Lukey.

Gives 5 shillings to **Mary Udy daughter of John Udy**.

Gives 5 shillings to the poor of the parish of Luxulyan.

Gives £80 to **his daughter Jane**, to be paid when she turns twenty-one. In the meantime, the interest on the same at the rate of 5% to be applied to her maintenance. After the death of her mother Katherine, Jane is to receive an additional £50.

If **his three daughters Ann, Catherine or Jane** should have a base child before they come of age, then the offending party is to forfeit £50 out of her portion.

All the rest of his goods and chattels, lands and tenements, tin works and tin bounds, he gives to **his two daughters Ann and Catherine**, share and share alike, appointing them co-executrices of his last will and testament.

Nominates **his brother Henry Udy** and William Hick of the parish of Lanlivery trustees and guardians of his children.
