

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/1894/275.

Abstract of the Will of William Vawdrey of the Parish of Gwinear in the County of Cornwall, Clerk, written 9 Feb 1838, proved 24 Apr 1838.

William refers to **his mother Ann Leonard the wife of Solomon Leonard** of the City of Bristol in county Gloucester, maltster, by whose will dated 27 Jun 1792, William and his heirs were made beneficiaries thereof.

Gives to **his three daughters Ann Ellen Vawdrey, Elizabeth Vawdrey and Mary Gwenellion Vawdrey** a tenement estate in Welder Street in the parish of St. Paul in the city of Bristol, as tenants in common.

Gives to **his son William Vawdrey** his tenement estate called The Leage situated in the parish of St. George in county Gloucester, subject to the payment of £150 to **his son John Glascott Vawdrey**. Also gives to his son William all his books, pictures and his violin.

Gives to **his sons Thomas Glascott Vawdrey and John Glascott Vawdrey** a tenement in the parish of St. Nicholas in the city of Bristol, as tenants in common, subject to the payment of an annuity of £40 to **his wife Mrs. Elizabeth Vawdrey** during her natural life.

Gives to **his son John Glascott Vawdrey** his tenement called Chappels Close in the parish of St. Philip and St. Jacob or the parish of St. George in county Gloucester. Also gives to his son John Glascott Vawdrey his leasehold premises called Bridge Gate in the parish of Wick and Abson in county Gloucester, subject to the payment of an annuity of £15 to John's mother, the said Elizabeth Vawdrey.

Gives to **his son George Vawdrey** £300 stock in the three percent Consols.

Gives to **his son Alexander Allen Vawdrey** £300 stock in the three percent Consols.

Gives to **his son Thomas Glascott Vawdrey** £300 stock in the three percent Consols.

Gives to **his daughter Esther Allen Parry** £300 stock in the three percent Consols.

Gives to **his daughter Rovena Lush** £300 stock in the three percent Consols.

Gives £5 each to **his children George, Alexander Allen, Thomas Glascott, Esther Allen and Rovena**.

Gives to his said wife Elizabeth Vawdrey an annuity or yearly rent charge of £15, along with his household furniture, linen, plate, china &c.

All the rest of his lands, tenements, hereditaments &c. he gives to **his son John Glascott Vawdrey**.

Appoints **his wife Elizabeth Vawdrey** and **his son Thomas Glascott Vawdrey** co-executors of his last will and testament.

The Rev. William Vawdrey was buried in Gwinear on 5 Apr 1838.
