

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/V/747 W.

Abstract of the Will of John Vivian of the Parish of Gwinear in the County of Cornwall, Shopkeeper, written 21 Mar 1820, with codicil, proved 20 Jun 1823.

Gives to **his two sons Joseph and John** his dwelling house and adjoining land, reserving £15 annually to be paid to **his daughter Elizabeth** during her natural life so long as she remains unmarried.

Gives £100 to **his daughter Mary the wife of Tho^s. Faul.**

Gives £100 to **his daughter Ann the wife of Samuel Grose.**

All the rest of his goods & effects he gives to **his daughter Elizabeth**, appointing her sole executrix of his will.

In a codicil dated 18 Dec 1822 he gives to **his son John** his one-third share in the Hanmer Mills and its stock in trade.
