*Abstract of the Will of John Webster of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 11 May 1823, proved 25 Apr 1826.*

Gives everything he possesses to **his wife Blanch Webster** for life.

Gives 1 shilling each to his four daughters.

Following the death of **his wife Blanch Webster**, he wills that **his four daughters Jane Phillips, Ann Viol, Grace Goldsworthy and Elizabeth Vivian** each receive a quarter share of what remains.

Administration of the goods &c of John Webster, yeoman, deceased, was granted to Blanch Webster, the widow and principal legatee named in the will, there being no executor named therein.

John Webster of Camborne was buried in Crowan on 3 Apr 1825, aged 73 years.
