Abstract of the Will of Alexander Williams of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Miner, written 28 May 1805, proved 12 Feb 1806.

Gives 1 shilling each to **his sons Alexander and John**.

Gives to Charles Thomas and Joseph Jeddy?, both of Camborne, miners, all his goods &c, in trust, for the benefit of **his wife Margaret, his daughter Margaret, his daughter Elizabeth, his daughter Jenefer, and his two sons Joseph and William**.

Gives 1 shilling to **his son James**.

Gives his clothing to **his son William**.

Appoints **his wife Margaret** sole executrix of his last will and testament.

Alexander Williams married twice in Camborne, first to Hannah Glanville on 26 Jan 1782 (Hannah was buried in Camborne on 27 Oct 1786), and second, to Margaret Ivey on 23 Mar 1788.

Alexander Williams was buried in Camborne on 7 Nov 1805.
