Abstract of the Will of James Williams of the Parish of Phillack, Yeoman, written 22 Sep 1843, proved 12 Jun 1844.

Gives all his real and personal estate to **his wife Honor** for life. Following her death he gives to **his two daughters Priscilla Williams and Treaza Eva** his leasehold dwelling house and land that he now occupies, in trust for the support of **his grandsons Elijah Williams, son of his late son Elijah, and Thomas Williams, son of his daughter Treaza Eva**. Once his said grandsons have turned twenty-one, he gives them £10 each, to be paid out of his tenement in Redruth. If his interest in the said tenement lapses before the said amounts are paid, then he will make liable his assurance policy with the Provident Life Assurance Company of London for £150 which will be deposited by his executors in one of the Cornish banks out of which the said £10 amounts shall then be paid.

Directs that the remainder of the £150 be equally divided between **James Odgers, son of his daughter Elizabeth, James Williams, son of his son Augustus**, the said **Priscilla Williams and Treaza Eva, Rispah Chegwin and Uriah Williams, his grandsons, daughters and son** respectively.

Also gives to his said daughters Priscilla Williams and Treaza Eva all his household goods and farming implements.

Gives to **his son Uriah Williams** his best great coat.

Gives to **his grandson Elijah** his silver watch, once he turns twenty-one.

Gives to every day clothing to **his son Augustus**.

All the rest of his personal estate and effects he gives to James Odgers, James Williams, Priscilla Williams, Treaza Eva, Rispah Chegwin and Uriah Williams.

Appoints Elizabeth Odgers, Augustus Williams, Priscilla Williams, Treaza Eva, Rispah Chegwin and Uriah Williams co-executors of his will.
