

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/W/2877 W.

Abstract of the Will of William Williams of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 7 Sep 1776, proved 9 Nov 1776.

Gives £50 to **his daughter Jane the wife of George Lemon**.

Gives one shilling to **his daughter Elizabeth the wife of Benjamin Glanville**.

Gives to **his brother Samuel Williams** and friends Martin Stephens and Matthew Bennetts of Camborne, in trust, the sum of £30 for the use of the children of his said daughter Elizabeth, to be equally divided between them.

Gives one shilling to **his daughter Catharine the wife of Benjamin Grible**.

Gives to his said trustees the sum of £100 for the use of the children of his daughter Catharine, to be equally divided between them.

Gives to his trustees the sum of £100 for each of **his daughters Clarinda and Phillipa Williams**.

Gives £5 to his servant Eleanor Bennetts.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives to his said trustees, appointing them co-executors in trust of his will and directing that they pay to **his son William Williams** an annuity of £40 until he turns twenty-seven, at which time he will inherit the residue of his father's estate.
