

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/913/119.

Abstract of the Will of Catherine Worth of the Borough of St. Ives in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 15 Jan 1755, proved 23 Oct 1765.

Gives 1 shilling to **her son Thomas Worth**, if living.

Gives 1 shilling to **her son Samuel Worth**.

Gives 1 shilling to **her daughter Bridget Vivian**, widow.

Gives 1 shilling to **her daughter Jane the wife of Clement Uren**.

Gives to **her daughter Catherine Worth**, spinster, all her clothing of linen, woolen and silk. Also gives to Catherine the dwelling in Fore Street in St. Ives.

Gives £100 to **her daughter Catherine Worth**.

All the rest of her real and personal estate, goods and chattels, she gives to **her son Charles Worth** the Younger, who she appoints sole executor of her last will and testament.
