

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers,  
PROB 11/914/93.

*Abstract of the Will of Thomas Worth of the Borough of St. Ives in the County of Cornwall, Mariner, written 21 Nov 1754, proved 27 Nov 1765.*

Gives 1 guinea in gold to **his son Thomas Worth**, if living.

Gives 1 guinea in gold to **his son Charles Worth** the Younger.

Gives 1 guinea to **his son Samuel Worth**.

Gives 1 guinea to **his daughter Bridget Vivian**, widow.

Gives 1 guinea to **his daughter Jane wife of Clement Uren** of the parish of Uny Lelant.

Gives 1 guinea to **his daughter Catherine Worth**, spinster.

All the rest of his real and personal estate, goods and chattels, he gives to **his wife Catherine Worth**, whom he appoints sole executrix of his last will and testament.

Administration (with the will annexed) was granted to **his son Charles Worth**, his wife Catherine having died before she could execute the will.
