Abstract of the Will of John Gliddon of Pancras Week, written 9 Jun 1812, proved 25 May 1814.

Gives 20 shillings to his son William the son of his first wife Honner.

Gives £3 to his son Samuel the son of his first wife Honner.

Gives £3 to his daughter Ann the daughter of his first wife Honner.

Gives £3 to his son Daniel the son of his second wife Ann.

Gives £3 to his son James.

Gives £3 to his son Elias.

Gives £3 to his daughter Susanna.

Gives £4 10s. a year to **his wife Ann** for as long as she shall live. And as long as she continues to live in the same house she shall have the use of the furniture therein and room in the garden to till 100 cabish [cabbage] plants and to bring in a hive of bees.

Gives 10 shillings to his grandchildren.

All the rest, residue and remainder of his goods, effects and property he gives to **his son Phillip** together with his estate in Kingford in the parish of Pancrasweek, making him sole executor of his last will and testament.
