Abstract of the Will of Benjamin Jordan of Halwill in the County of Devon, Yeoman, written 18 Sep 1825, proved 20 Dec 1827.

Gives £5 each to his nephews and nieces Benjamin Jordon, John Jordon, James Jordon, Josias Jordon, Mary Jordon, Dorothy Jordon, Jane Jordon and Charity Jordon, sons and daughters of his brother Josias Jordon.

Gives £5 each to his nephews and niece Mary Jordon, James Jordon and John Jordon daughter and sons of his brother John Jordon.

Gives £10 to his niece Margaret Jordon daughter of his said brother Josias Jordon.

Gives £5 each to his nephew and nieces William Jordon, Dorothy Jordon and Elizabeth Jordon son and daughters of his brother William Jordon.

Gives £5 each to Peter Hill of the parish of Ashwater in county Devon, yeoman, Peter Hill the younger his son, and Frances Toby of Halwill, widow.

Gives £100 each to his brothers John Jordon and William Jordon.

Gives a weekly annuity of 3 shillings to his sister Elizabeth Jordon.

Gives a yearly annuity of £5 to his brother James Jordon.

All the rest and residue of his goods, chattels, lands, tenements, personal and testamentary estate he gives and bequeaths to his said **brother Josias Jordon** and his heirs executors administrators and assigns, making him the sole executor of his last will and testament.
