

Consistory Court of Gloucester, reference 68305.

*Abstract of the Will of Charles Spackman of Cheltenham in the County of Gloucester, Plasterer, written 4 Oct 1848, proved 13 Feb 1852.*

Appoints **his son Charles William Spackman** and his friend James Downing of Cheltenham, draper, as co-executors of his last will and testament, to whom he gives & bequeaths all his real and personal estate to hold in trust and convert into money to be invested in Government or real security.

Directs his trustees to pay **his wife Ann** out of the proceeds of the rents and profits of his real estate, for the term of her natural life. And after her death he wills the same to be shared equally between all his children.
