

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/127/505.

*Abstract of the Will of Richard Langrish of the Parish of Havant in Hampshire, Gentleman, written 19 Oct 1615, proved 7 May 1616.*

Makes bequests to the cathedral churches of Chichester and Winton and to the churches of Havant, East-----, Bosham, Funtington and Warblington.

Makes bequests to the poor of Havant, East-----, Bosham, Funtington & Warblington.

Gives 40 shillings to **his daughter Anne Pay** and 20 shillings each to every child she has by **Francis Pay her current husband**.

Gives 3 shillings 4 pence to **his godson Richard Burrell**.

Gives £20 to **his son John Langrish**.

Gives 20 shillings each to the daughters of **his sister Humffrey** deceased.

Gives £60 to **his grandchildren Robert & Elizabeth Coulden the children of his son-in-law Peter Coulden deceased**, to be equally divided among them.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to **his grandson Richard Langrish son of his eldest son Robert Langrish**.

Appoints **Elizabeth Langrish his wife** sole executrix of his last will and testament.
