Makes bequests to the cathedral churches of Chichester and Winton and to the churches of Havant, East----, Bosham, Funtington and Warblington.

Makes bequests to the poor of Havant, East----, Bosham, Funtington & Warblington.

Gives 40 shillings to **his daughter Anne Pay** and 20 shillings each to every child she has by **Francis Pay her current husband**.

Gives 3 shillings 4 pence to his godson Richard Burrell.

Gives £20 to his son John Langrish.

Gives 20 shillings each to the daughters of his sister Humffrey deceased.

Gives £60 to his grandchildren Robert & Elizabeth Coulden the children of his son-in-law Peter Coulden deceased, to be equally divided among them.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to his grandson Richard Langrish son of his eldest son Robert Langrish.

Appoints **Elizabeth Langrish his wife** sole executrix of his last will and testament.
