

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/905/443.

Abstract of the Will of Humphry Bartholomew of West Malling in the County of Kent, Doctor of Physick, written 23 Jun 1756, proved 21 Feb 1765.

Gives £100 to the governors and trustees of St. Thomas Hospital in the borough of Southwark, co. Surrey.

Gives £100 to Mr. Samuel Pearce, late apothecary to the said hospital.

Gives £100 each to **his nephew Leonard Bartholomew** of Oxenheath and **niece Mary wife of Captain Francis Geary**, to buy themselves mourning.

Made bequests to his servants (amount illegible).

Gives an annuity of £10 to his maid servant Margaret Dunkin.

Gives to **his nephew Leonard Bartholomew, son of his late brother Leonard Bartholomew** of Addington, Esquire, his manors, lands, tenements & hereditaments, in trust, along with all the rest of his goods, chattels and personal estate, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
