

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/526/73.

*Abstract of the Will of Sir Humphry Miller of Oxenhoath in the Parish of West Peckham in the County of Kent, Baronet, written 4 Jul 1709, proved 12 Mar 1711/2.*

Gives £100 to **his son Borlase Miller**.

Gives £20 each to his friends and trustees Sir Thomas Twisden, Percivall Hart, Esquire, and Thomas Lambard, Esquire.

Gives cloth for mourning to **his son Borlase Miller, his daughter Bartholomew\***, **his daughter Anne Miller, his nephew Humphry Miller, and his sister Hardesty**.

\* Humphrey's daughter, Elizabeth, married Leonard Bartholomew of Rochester, gent.

Gives £21 10s. to Mr. Francis Twisden.

Gives £21 10s. to his servant Ann Wilson.

Gives £10 to his servant Robert Wood.

Gives 20 shillings each to his other servants.

Gives £5 each to the poor of the parishes of West Peckham, Hadlow and Wrotham.

All the rest of his goods & chattels he gives to **his son Borlase Miller and nephew Humphry Miller**, appointing them co-executors of his last will, and nominates his said trustees as overseers of his will.
