*Abstract of the Will of Walter Boothby of Tottenham High Cross in the County of
Middlesex, written 12 Mar 1668/9, proved 14 Jul 1669.*

Gives to **his wife Katharyne Boothby** all his plate, jewells and household stuff, his
four houses in Thames

Gives to **his daughter Martha**

Gives to **his son Isaac** his houses in St. Augustine

Gives to his daughters Mary and Hanna the lease of his house in

. As for his lands and houses in Chancery Lane and in St. Dunstons
the Wise purchased from the State for £800, he gives & bequeaths to **his four
youngest daughters Frances, Mary, Hanna and Martha**, to be equally divided
between them.

Appoints his wife Katherine Boothby as sole executrix of his last will an testament,
and **his son Joliffe** [as overseer].
