Gives to Edward Wotson half a bushel of wheat.

Gives £26 13s. 4d. to his eldest son Thomas.

Gives £26 13s. 4d. to his son John.

Gives £26 13s. 4d. to his youngest son Robert.

Gives £13 6s. 8d. to his daughter Elizabeth.

Gives £13 6s. 8d. to his daughter Anne.

Gives to his cousin Julyan Hacher one bushel of wheat.

All the rest of his goods he gives to <u>his wife Anne</u>, appointing her sole executrix of his last will and testament.
