

London, England, Wills and Probate, 1507-1858, DW/PA/S/1558/193.

*Abstract of the Will of Richard Maunsell of the Parish of Horley in the County of Surrey, Scrivener, written 20 Aug 1558, proved 11 Nov 1558.*

Wills that his body be buried in the parish churchyard of Horley.

Bequeaths to each of his godchildren 2 pence.

Bequeaths a ewe sheep to each of his daughters' children.

Bequeaths to his godson John Venesshe one sheep.

Bequeaths to his daughter Johane a heifer bullock aged three years.

All the rest and residue of his goods and chattels he gives and bequeaths to his sons William and Robert to be equally divided between them and who he appoints co-executors of his last will and testament.

Makes Richard Braye of Horley overseer of his last will and testament, paying his 3 shillings 4 pence for his efforts.
