Bequeaths to her executor all her furniture, glass, china, books and pictures in Trust to be disposed of among her relatives at his discretion.

Bequeaths her gold chain and diamonds to her niece Harriet Collier.

Bequeaths her watch, her necklace and bracelets of gold net to **her niece Clementine Collier**.
