

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers,
PROB 11/2110/210.

*Abstract of the Will of Miss Charlotte Nicholas of Norwood in the Parish of Croydon
in the County of Surrey, Spinster, written 12 Feb 1850, proved 9 Mar 1850.*

Appoints **Henry Theodosius Brown Collier**, Captain of the Royal Navy, sole
executor of her last will and testament.

Bequeaths to **her three sisters Harriet Collier, Sophia Nicholas and Frances
Nicholas** £607 3s. 7d. worth of annuities in the Bank of England, to share and share
alike.

Bequeaths £664 7s. 6d. worth of annuities in the Bank of England to **her sister
Elenor Hyndman**, along with all her wearing apparel.

Bequeaths to her executor all her furniture, glass, china, books and pictures in Trust
to be disposed of among her relatives at his discretion.

Bequeaths her gold chain and diamonds to **her niece Harriet Collier**.

Bequeaths her watch, her necklace and bracelets of gold net to **her niece
Clementine Collier**.
