Abstract of the Will of John Barnard Senior of the Parish of Goring in the County of Sussex, written 1591, proved 1612.

Gives to the church of Chichester 4 pence.

Gives to the poor people of Goring 10 shillings.

Gives to his wife £40.

Gives to <u>his son Benjamin Barnard</u> £100, to be paid to him when he turns twenty-one.

Gives to his son Daniel Barnard £100, to be paid to him when he turns twenty-one.

Gives to <u>his daughter Elizabeth Barnard</u> £50, to be paid to her on her day of marriage.

Gives to his daughter Sarah Barnard £50, to be paid to her on her day of marriage.

Gives to <u>his daughter Rebecka Barnard</u> £50, to be paid to her on her day of marriage.

Gives 12 pence to each of his godchildren.

Wills that John Sander shall be [provided for] so long as he lives.

All the rest of his goods he gives to <u>his son John Barnard</u> whom he makes sole executor.

Desires that his friends <u>Thomas Cooke</u> and <u>Anthony Barnard</u> be overseers, paying them 4 shillings 4 pence for their efforts.
