Abstract of the Will of Thomas Barnard in the Parish of Goring and County of Sussex, written 1585, proved 1586.

Gives and bequeaths 8 pence to the church of Chichester.

Gives and bequeaths to his poor neighbours in the parish of Goring his half a quarter of malt.

Gives and bequeaths to his servants 10 bushels of barley.

Gives and bequeaths 20 shillings to <u>his brother's son Anthony Barnard</u>, as well as a quarter of barley and his old wearing apparel.

Gives and bequeaths £40 to his daughter Annis Barnard.

Gives and bequeaths £40 to his son Thomas Barnard.

Gives and bequeaths £40 to his son William Barnard.

Gives and bequeaths £40 to his youngest son Henry Barnard.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to <u>Joane his wife</u>, along with his best bed and all his furniture, ten pairs of sheets, as well as a place in his house and meat and drink provided by <u>his son John Barnard</u> for the term of her natural life or for as long as she remains unmarried.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives and bequeaths to <u>his son John</u> <u>Barnard</u> whom he makes sole executor of his last will and testament.
