*Abstract of the Will of Henry Blackman of Warbleton in the County of Sussex,
Yeoman, written 3 Jan 1849, proved 29 Nov 1853.*

Gives £10 to his housekeeper Sophia Pilbeam.

Gives £10 to Ann Pilbeam currently living in his house.

Gives, devises and bequeaths his tenement buildings, farms, lands, hereditaments and real estate, together with all his personal estate and effects, ready money, securities for money, household goods and furniture, livestock and farming effects, to his nephews Henry Christmas and Thomas Christmas in Trust, to sell by public auction or private contract, and from the proceeds to pay to the said Henry Christmas and Thomas Christmas, and to his niece and nephews Harriet the wife of Edward Davey, Stephen Christmas and Charles Christmas, to be equally divided between them.

Appoints the said Henry Christmas and Thomas Christmas co-executors of his will.

Witnesses: William Burgess of Warbleton, innkeeper, Benjⁿ Buss of Mayfield, solicitor.

Testator died 4 Jul 1853.
