The last will of Margarett Bodle of Haylsham widdowe made the One & Thirtith Day of March Anno Dⁿⁱ 1645. *Impris* I give unto **my sonne John Akeherst** one silver salt fower silver spoones Three kine one sowe one sheat-- one brasse Caldron Itm I give unto **Jone Akeherst wife of the said John Akeherst** my old mare Itm I give more to **my said sonne John** one Bedsteddle standing in the Chamber over the old milkhowse And alsoe one great Chest one great Trunk one presse one Bedsteddle and one Table standing in the hall Chamber And alsoe one Table and frame and one Cupbord standing in the parlor And alsoe two Tables standing in the hall Itm I give unto **Margaret Akeherst daughter of the said John Akeherst** my Redd flannell petticote laid with three black velvett laces And the rest of my howsehold stuffe not before given and bequeathed my will and minde is that it should be equally devided betweene the said **John Akeherst and my two Daughters Eve and Martha** And I doe make the said **John Akeherst** sole and only executor of this my last will & testamt
