*Abstract of the Will of John Bright of Hailsham in the County of Sussex, Cook, written
12 Apr 1639, proved 7 May 1639.*

Gives 4 shillings to the poor of the parish of Hailsham.

Gives & bequests to his wife Mercie all goods and money that came from her
mohter, as well as £10, a fletch of bacon, and his best bed in the chamber above the
hall.

Gives £20 to his son George, making his brother[-in-law] Crowherst trustee.

Gives £5 to his son-in-law John Hewet and the leases of his house and land, and
makes him the sole executor of his Will.
