Gives 4 shillings to the poor of the parish of Hailsham.

Gives & bequests to <u>his wife Mercie</u> all goods and money that came from her mohter, as well as £10, a fletch of bacon, and his best bed in the chamber above the hall.

Gives £20 to his son George, making his brother[-in-law] Crowherst trustee.

Gives £5 to <u>his son-in-law John Hewet</u> and the leases of his house and land, and makes him the sole executor of his Will.
