Abstract of the Will of Benjamin Bristed the Elder of Warbleton in the County of Sussex, Yeoman, written 26 Feb 1753, proved 30 Jan 1758.

Gives and bequeaths £100 to <u>Benjamin Blackman son of his nephew John Blackman</u>, to be paid to him when he turns twenty-one.

Gives and bequeaths £50 to his maid servant Elizabeth Payne, along with selected household goods.

Gives and bequeaths all his wearing linen to his brother James Bristed.

Gives and bequeaths to his late servant Thomas Payne son of Thomas Payne of Heathfield all his woollen clothing (except the silver buttons thereon).

Forgives his cousin James Bristed the amounts he owes.

Forgives his cousin Richard Bristed the amounts he owes.

All the rest and remainder of his goods, chattels, furniture, stock, and personal estate he gives and bequeaths to <u>his cousin Benjamin Bristed</u>, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
