Abstract of the Will of Richard Burtenshaw the Elder of the Parish of Lindfield in the County of Sussex, Yeoman, written 19 Nov 1716, proved 4 May 1717.

Gives, devises and bequeaths to <u>his son Richard Burtenshaw</u> and his heirs 70 acres of land along with its tenements and hereditaments called Nashlands in Lindfield.

Gives and bequeaths 10 shillings each to <u>his daughters Mary Johnson the wife of</u> William Johnson of Wivelsfield and Sarah Burt, widow.

Gives and bequeaths to <u>his daughter Sarah Burt, widow</u>, a featherbed with its stedle, curtains, vallance, rods, pillows, bolsters and blankets, along with a half-bushell iron pot.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to his son John Burtenshaw.

Gives and bequeaths £30 to <u>his granddaughter Mary Johnson daughter of William Johnson</u>.

Gives and bequeaths £10 to <u>his granddaughter Sarah Johnson daughter of William</u> Johnson.

All the rest and residue of his goods, chattels and personal estate he gives and bequeaths to <u>his son Richard Burtenshaw</u> whom he makes sole executor of his last will and testament.
