Gives and bequeaths 5 shillings each to <u>his daughters Mary the wife of Thomas Vallance</u>, <u>Sarah the relict of Thomas Carey deceased</u>, <u>Elizabeth the wife of John Thatcher</u>, and Martha Chapman his youngest daughter.

Notes that <u>his eldest daughter Mary</u> has already received her portion except £5 for which he has made out a bill and given it to <u>her husband Thomas Vallance</u> to be paid to her after Joseph's decease. His other daughters have already been paid their bonds in full at the times of their marriages.

Appoints <u>his son-in-law John Thatcher</u> and <u>his nephew Richard Bristed of Crawle in Warbleton</u> co-executors of his last will.
