Charles Christmas of Bexhill, gentleman, died intestate. A bond of £1,500 was paid by his brothers Thomas Christmas 'the Younger' of Bexhill, gentleman, Henry Christmas of Heathfield, farmer, and cousin Edward Davey of Brighton, butcher. Letters of Administration were granted to the said Thomas Christmas of Bexhill on 3 Jul 1854.

On 15 Oct 1854 an act of court reswearing his brother, the administrator Thomas Christmas of Bexhill, gent, to a revised valuation of the estate, and administration bond in £6000.
