Abstract of the Will of Richard Dumbrell of the Parish of Wivelsfield in the County of Sussex, Yeoman, written 3 Nov 1657, proved 14 Jun 1658.

Gives and bequeaths £20 each to <u>his four daughters Margarett, Jane, Mary and Elizabeth</u>, once they each turn twenty-one.

Appoints <u>his sons Richard Dumbrell and Thomas Dumbrell</u> co-executors of his last will and testament and residuary legatees.

Gives and bequeaths to <u>his wife Jane</u> 40 shillings a year for the term of her natural life, along with the parlour chamber in his dwelling house, a featherbed and all its appurtenances, a billett of faggots yearly for the maintenance of her fire.
