*Abstract of the Will of William Eaton of Guestling in the County of Sussex,
Blacksmith, written 23 Sep 1833, proved 5 Apr 1838.*

Appoints his wife Elizabeth Eaton, his son William Eaton and his nephew John Eaton of Hastings, upholsterer, co-executors of his will.

Gives, devises and bequeaths to his wife Elizabeth all his real and personal estate for the term of her natural life. After her decease he gives and bequeaths the same in Trust to the said William Eaton and John Eaton, in order to sell the said real and personal estate and divide the proceeds among his children, namely the said William Eaton, Elizabeth Eaton, Mary Eaton, Henry Eaton, Benjamin Eaton, John Eaton, and Thomas Eaton, with an additional £50 going to William.
