Gives, devises and bequeaths to <u>his wife Elizabeth</u> all his real and personal estate for the term of her natural life. After her decease he gives and bequeaths the same in Trust to the said <u>William Eaton</u> and <u>John Eaton</u>, in order to sell the said real and personal estate and divide the proceeds among <u>his children</u>, namely the said <u>William Eaton</u>, <u>Elizabeth Eaton</u>, <u>Mary Eaton</u>, <u>Henry Eaton</u>, <u>Benjamin Eaton</u>, <u>John Eaton</u>, and Thomas Eaton, with an additional £50 going to William.
