*Abstract of the Will of Nicholas Fairhill of the City of Chichester in the County of Sussex, Patternmaker, written 25 Jan 1708/9, proved 4 Aug 1714.*

Gives and bequeaths to his daughter Mary the silver porringer and spoon marked with the first two letters of her name.

Gives and bequeaths to his daughter Susann the silver porringer and spoon marked with the first two letters of her name.

Gives and bequeaths to his daughter Elizabeth the silver cup and spoon marked with the first two letters of her name.

Gives and bequeaths to his son John a silver salt marked with the first two letters of his name and also a silver spoon.

Gives and bequeaths to his son Thomas a silver salt marked with the first two letters of his name and also a silver spoon.

Gives and bequeaths to his son Christopher a silver spoon.

Gives and bequeaths to his son Langrish Fairhill one silver spoon.

All the rest of his goods, chattels and personal estate he gives and bequeaths to his wife Susann whom he appoints sole executrix of his last will and testament.
