Abstract of the Will of Susannah Farhill of the City of Chichester in the County of Sussex, Widow, written 20 Jun 1743, proved 21 Mar 1744/5.

Gives & devises to her eldest son John Farhill and her daughter Mary Sedgwick and their heirs her dwelling house and garden with the appurtenances in the North Street of the said city currently occupied by herself and her son-in-law George Sedgwick.

Gives £225 each to her son Langrish Farhill and daughter Ann Farhill.

Gives £40 each to her grandchildren Elizabeth, Ann, Mary & Susannah, children of her late son Thomas Farhill.

Gives to her said daughter Mary Sedgwick the bed & furniture from her best chamber.

All the rest of her household goods she gives to her said daughters and son Mary, Ann and Langrish, share and share alike.

All the residue of her personal estate she gives to her son John and daughter Mary, making them executor and executrix of her last will and testament.
