

Church of England, Peculiar Court (Deanery of South Malling), ESRO reference: PBT 2/1/7/98.

*Abstract of the Will of Jeremiah Gower of the Parish of Lindfield in the County of Sussex, Shearman, written 30 Aug 1740, proved 1 Jan 1741.*

Gives and bequeaths £20 to his daughter Sarah Cox wife of John Cox of Keymer, husbandman.

Gives and bequeaths to his son Jeremiah Gower of Ardingly and his heirs three acres of field or meadow in Lindfield town common, currently occupied by his son John Gower or his assigns.

Gives and bequeaths to his son John Gower and his heirs his dwelling house with its outhouses, buildings, gardens, orchard, and associated premises.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to his daughter Hannah Osborn the wife of Thomas Osborn of Whiteing in co. Sussex, husbandman.

All the rest of his goods, chattels, debts, credits, and personal estate he gives to his two sons Jeremiah Gower and John Gower, share and share alike, appointing them co-executors of his last will and testament.
