Gives and bequeaths £20 to <u>his daughter Sarah Cox wife of John Cox</u> of Keymer, husbandman.

Gives and bequeaths to <u>his son Jeremiah Gower</u> of Ardingly and his heirs three acres of field or meadow in Lindfield town common, currently occupied by <u>his son John Gower</u> or his assigns.

Gives and bequeaths to <u>his son John Gower</u> and his heirs his dwelling house with its outhouses, buildings, gardens, orchard, and associated premises.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to <u>his daughter Hannah Osborn the wife of Thomas Osborn</u> of Whiteing in co. Sussex, husbandman.

All the rest of his goods, chattels, debts, credits, and personal estate he gives to <u>his</u> two sons Jeremiah Gower and John Gower, share and share alike, appointing them co-executors of his last will and testament.
