reference: PBT/1/1/24/53C.

*Abstract of the Will of Richard Langford of the Parish of Bexhill in the County of
Sussex, written 1 May 1635, proved 5 Dec 1635.*

Wills that his body be buried in the churchyard of Bexhill.

Gives £10 to his eldest son Edward Langford.

Gives £20 to his son Robert Langford.

Gives £20 to his wife Joane as well as the use and profit of all his goods and chattels
so long as she maintains their children during their minority.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives to his youngest son Thomas whom he
makes executor of his last will and testament.

Makes William Paynter, Alexander Paynter and his brother John Langford trustees.
