Abstract of the Will of Thomas Langrishe of the Parish of West Ashling in the County of Sussex, Gentleman, written 15 May 1641, proved 26 Jun 1641.

Gives £200 each to <u>his daughters Elizabeth Langrishe</u>, <u>Joane Langrishe</u> and <u>Ann Langrishe</u>.

After the death of <u>his wife Ann</u> he bequeaths to <u>his son George Langrishe</u> all his lease lands in the parish of Aldingbourne in co. Sussex.

Gives to <u>his son Christopher Langrishe</u> his lease lands called 'Sparrowes Gringe' in Broadbridge in the parish of Bosham co. Sussex, once he turns twenty-one.

Gives five shillings each to <u>his four sons George Langrishe</u>, <u>Thomas Langrishe</u>, <u>Christopher Langrishe</u> and <u>William Langrishe</u>.

All the rest and residue of his goods, chattels and credits he gives to <u>his wife Ann</u> whom he appoints sole executrix of his last will and testament.

Desires that his friends William Cooper, Christopher Peshall and Adam Dalington be the overseers of his will and assist his wife in the execution thereof, giving them 5 shillings each for their efforts.
