

England & Wales, Prerogative Court of Canterbury Wills, 1384-1858, PROB 11/2151/363.

*Abstract of the Will of Samuel Roods of the Parish of Westham in the County of Sussex, yeoman, written 10 Aug 1842, proved 27 Apr 1852.*

Gives, devises and bequeaths to his sisters Elizabeth Roods and Harriett Roods all his messuages, buildings, lands, tenements, hereditaments and real estate, along with the rest, residue and remainder of his goods, chattels, effects, monies, securities for monies, rights, credits and personal estate, for the term of their natural lives. And after they have deceased he gives, devises and bequeaths the same to his nephews Henry Crowhurst Roods and William Edward Roods as trustees, to sell and divide the profits between the children of his late brother Henry Crowhurst Roods deceased.

Appoints his said nephews Henry Crowhurst Roods and William Edward Roods co-executors of his last will and testament.
