Gives 5 shillings to his daughter Catherine.

Gives 5 shillings each to the six children of his said daughter Catherine now wife of Thomas West.

Gives 2 shillings sixpence each to the two children of his daughter Sarah who was the wife of Henry Willard.

Gives to <u>his kinswoman Frances Mackley</u> the dwelling in his house during her widowhood. He also gives her milk of one cow for five years so long as she remains a widow and looks after the house, garden, orchard and field.

Gives to <u>his son William Stace</u> his house, garden, orchard and field, and all the rest of his goods, making him executor of his last will and testament.
