Abstract of the Will of Sarah Stoner of the Parish of West Hoathly in the County of Sussex, widow, written 4 Dec 1719, proved 27 Mar 1725.

Gives, wills, and bequeaths £5 to the children of <u>Abraham Stoner</u> of West Hoathly deceased.

Gives £5 each to her daughter Elizabeth Spatchurst and her daughter Gourd*.

Gives, wills and bequeaths to <u>her son John Stoner</u> of London one guinea of gold and one silver spoon.

Gives one shilling to her daughter Hanah.

All the rest of her goods and chattels, bills, bonds, and ready money she gives to <u>her son Thomas Stoner</u> of West Hoathly, making him sole executor of her last will and testament.
