Abstract of the Will of Jone Swan of the Parish of West Hoathly in County of Sussex, Widow, written 2 Jul 1684, proved 2 Dec 1684.

Gives and bequeaths £30 to <u>her granddaughter Hannah Dungate the wife of John Dungate</u>, this being in addition to the £10 already given to Hannah's husband to be paid to Hannah following the decease of Jone.

Gives and bequeaths £5 each to the children of <u>her granddaughter Hannah Dungate</u> aforesaid.

Gives and bequeaths £5 each to the children of <u>her granddaughter Sarah Stoner the</u> <u>wife of Thomas Stoner</u>.

Gives and bequeaths to <u>her grandchildren John Paine and Elizabeth Paine</u>, <u>children of her granddaughter Mary Paine the wife of John Paine</u>, two tables, and to the said <u>Elizabeth Paine</u> she gives and bequeaths £5 to be paid to her when she turns twenty-one or marries, whichever comes first.

Gives 20 shillings each to Elizabeth Laker the wife of Thomas Laker and their son John Laker.

Gives 40 shillings to her son-in-law Abraham Nicholas.

Gives all her remaining household stuff to <u>her grandchildren Abraham Nicholas</u>, <u>Sarah Stoner the wife of Thomas Stoner</u>, and to <u>Hannah Dungate the wife of John</u> Dungate.

All the rest of her goods and chattels she gives and bequeaths to <u>her grandson</u> <u>Abraham Nicholas</u>, making him sole executor of her last will and testament.
